I. BASIC DOCTRINE - GOD

A. Introduction

Colossians 1:9-10 John 17:3 Daniel 11:32

John 17:3-4

And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

B. The Existence of God

Hebrews 11:6 Genesis 1:1

Heb 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him

1. Universal **belief** in God cones from within man.

Romans 1:18-32

Rom 8:21

because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

- 2. The argument from "cause and effect." Everything that is owes its existence to a creator. We have a watch; we must have a watchmaker. We have a creation; then we must have a creator. This creation could not have come into existence without an intelligent personal creator.
- 3. Man's **moral** and **intellectual** nature argues for a moral and intellectual creator.
- 4. **Psalm 14:1** The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God."

C. The attributes of GOD

What makes GOD, GOD? Infinite - without limits.

1. **Eternal** - Not limited by time.

1 Timothy 1:17 Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, {be} honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

2. **Omnipotent** - Not limited in power.

Creator and sustainer of all things.

a) El Shaddai \rightarrow God Almighty Genesis 17:1

When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless.

b) YHWH first used with God as creator Exodus 3:14 (Genesis 2:4) Isaiah 41:4; 43:10-13, Isaiah 44:6; 48:12

- c) "Is anything too difficult for the LORD?" **Genesis 18:14**
- d) "... With God all things are possible" Matthew 19:26
- e) **Revelation 19:6** Rev 1:8 Isaiah 42:5; 45:12,18; 48:13

6 And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!

3. **Omniscient** - He is not limited in knowledge, wisdom or intelligence

4. **Omnipresent** - He is not limited by space.

13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

- 5. **Righteous** ruler of the universe.
 - a) **Genesis 14:19** El Elyon → "Most High God, Possessor of heaven & earth."

19 The LORD has established His throne in heaven, And His kingdom rules over all.

6. Life **unlimited** and the only source of life.

7. **Immutable** - He does not change. Unlimited in perfection.

F. The Trinity of God

1. By the trinity of God we mean that God is **ONE** (Deuteronomy 6:4) and is revealed in three persons as FATHER, SON and HOLY SPIRIT (Ephesians 4:4-6). One in thought, purpose, action and work.

Deut 6:4

4 "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one!

Eph 4:4-6

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling;5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism;6 one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

2. The **FATHER** is recognized as God (1 Peter 1:2) and is all the fullness of the Godhead invisible (John 1:18).

1 Peter 1:2

2 elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace be multiplied.

Iohn 1:17-18

No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

3. The **SON** is recognized as God (Hebrews 1:8) and is all the fullness of the Godhead manifested in the flesh (John 1:1, 14).

Heb 1:8

8 But to the Son He says:

"Your throne, O God, is forever and ever;

A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom.) *John 1:14*

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

4. The **HOLY SPIRIT** is recognized as God (Acts 5:3-4) and is all the fullness of the Godhead acting upon man, convicting him of sin (John 16:7-11) and guiding the believer into all truth (John 16:12-15).

Acts 5:3-4

3 But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself?4 While it remained, was it not your own? And after it was sold, was it not in your own control? Why have you conceived this thing in your heart? You have not lied to men but to God."

5. The doctrine of the Trinity is not **explicit** in the Old Testament, but is rather implied. "And God said, 'Let us make man . . .:" (Genesis 1:26).

Gen 1:26

26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

6. The doctrine of the Trinity is revealed in the **New Testament**. In Matthew 3:16-17, we have Christ being baptized in water, the Father speaking from heaven, and the Holy Spirit descending as a dove. We are to baptize in the name, not names, "of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28:19).

II BASIC DOCTRINE - MAN

A. Man's Beginning

Where did man come from? Genesis 1:26-28; 2:7, 18, 21-25

Gen 1:26-28

26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." 27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. 28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

B. Man's condition when first created

- 1. **Perfect**:
 - a) Without sin, sickness or death, eternal.
 - b) Walked with God.

Genesis 1:31; 3:8

- 2. Made in the **image** or likeness of God
 - a) Advanced or great **intellectual** capability. **Colossians 3:10**

Col 3:10

and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him

b) **Moral** and **righteous** - knew and did only what was good.

Ephesians 4:24

24 and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

c) Free. Could make his own choices. Genesis 2:16-17

16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; 17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

- d) An **eternal** being.
- 3. A **three** part being: spirit soul body.
 - a) Genesis 2:7 Body from dust. Spirit and soul from the breath (Spirit) of God.
 - b) 1 Thessalonians 5:23

23 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

III. BASIC DOCTRINE - SIN

A. Introduction

Two Facts:

Man makes so **little** of sin. Proverb 14:9 "fools mock at sin." God makes so **much** of sin. Genesis 6:5-7

5 Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. 6 And the LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. 7 So the LORD said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them."

Matthew 5:29-30

The seriousness of sin.

B. What is Sin?

D. How Sin entered the world

Romans 5:12

12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned

- E. The results of $sin \rightarrow death$.

Ephesians 2:1Romans 6:23

Eph 2:1

2:1 And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins,

Rom 6:22-23

23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Death does not annihilate; it separates.

- 1. The wages of sin is: **SPIRITUAL** DEATH.
 - a) Spirit and soul **separated** from God who is life. Genesis 2:16-17 Isaiah 59:2 Ezekiel 18:4, 20

Isaiah 59:2

2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear.

- 2. The wages of sin is: **PHYSICAL** DEATH. Spirit and soul separated from the body.
 - a) When the body stops functioning and physical death is complete, the spirit and soul return to God for judgment.

Psalm 104:29; 90:10 Ecclesiastes 12:7 Job 34:14-15 Hebrews 9:27

Ps 104:29

29 You hide Your face, they are troubled; You take away their breath, they die and return to their dust.

And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment

3. The wages of sin is:

a) **ETERNAL DEATH**. Eternal separation from the mercy of God.

b. But for the one forgiven by the death of Jesus Christ \rightarrow ETERNAL LIFE.

C. The Savior - Jesus Christ

Luke 2:30; 3:6

Luke 2:30

30 For my eyes have seen Your salvation

6 And all flesh shall see the salvation of God.'

Salvation requires one who is able to save. One who has the AUTHORITY and POWER. **Isaiah 43:3, 11-13; 45:21**

1 John 4:14 "The Father sent the Son to be the **Savior** of the world."

Luke 2:30; 3:6 Jesus is called The **Salvation** of God.



1. THE **DEITY** OF JESUS CHRIST - HE IS GOD.

- a) Jehovah of the Old Testament is **Jesus** of the New Testament. Isaiah 44:6; 41:4; 48:12
 Revelation 1:8, 17; 22:13
- b) He is **Eternal**. Only God is eternal.

1 Timothy 1:17; 6:14-16 Micah 5:2

c) He is **God** and CREATED all things

John 1:1-4, 14, 18

d) He **holds** all things together

Hebrews 1:3, Colossians 1:17

e) The fullness of **Deity** dwells in Him.

Colossians 2:9

f) Existed in the form of God and **Equal** with God

Philippians 2:6

g) Jesus came from God with **Authority**.

John 8:42 Galatians 4:4

h) States His **pre-existence** and that He is Jehovah of the Old Testament.

John 8:51-59 Exodus 3:14

i) States His **unity** or one essence with God the Father.

j) Called **God** by the Father.

Hebrews 1:8

k) Forgives sin. Only God can forgive sin.

Luke 5:20-24

- l) Stated He had all **power** in heaven and earth. Only God has all power.
- 2. BECAME **A MAN**. REMAINED GOD. SON OF GOD and SON OF MAN.

Philippians 2:5-11

5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. 9 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

- a) Because sinful man was in need of salvation which required a Savior, and only **God** can save.
- b) **Luke 19:10** "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.
- c) **1 Timothy 1:15** "... Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners."
- d) God, Jesus Christ, was born into this world as a **man**.
- e) Became as one of us. Hebrews 2:14-17; 4:14-15 Zechariah 9:9

A member of the Godhead came into the human family giving us a member of the human family to represent us in the Godhead.

- f) Sin came by one man. **Salvation** came by one man. Romans 5:12, 18-19
- g) Jesus did what Adam failed to do lived a **sinless** life. 1 Corinthians 15:21-22 Hebrews 4:15

D. The death of the Savior, on the cross of Calvary

1. HE TOOK MY **PLACE**Romans 5:6,8; 8:32
2 Corinthians 5:21
Isaiah 53 Colossians 2:13-15

- 2. **REDEEMING** To deliver or save by paying a price to purchase.
 - a) Greek: To **buy** in the market. Man is a slave, "sold under sin" (Romans 7:14) and under the sentence of death (Romans 6:23) but was purchased by Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 6:17-20; 7:23)

b) **Purchased** all men 2 Peter 2:1 Titus 2:11-14 and therefore has the right to do with them as He pleases.

c) The **Price**: Blood Rev 5:9 1 Peter 1:18-19

d) For How Long? Hebrews 9:12

e) **Greek:** TO LOOSE OR SET FREE

(i) From lawless deeds, iniquity Titus 2:14

(ii) From transgression and **sin** Ephesians 1:7 giving forgiveness.

3. **JUSTIFYING** thus MAKING RIGHTEOUS

JUST Legally right

JUSTIFY To free from blame, declare not guilty.

RIGHTEOUS Morally right, just.

Romans 3:21-28

- a) V 21 The moral **righteousness** of God was seen in the law and is now seen in Jesus Christ and His saving work.
- b) V 22 The righteousness of God is given to all who believe and put their **faith** in Jesus Christ ALONE for Salvation.

- c) V 24 As a gift by His grace, He legally declares righteous or justified, those who believe, because of the **redemptive** work of Jesus Christ. It is a FREE GIFT. Undeserved. Could not be purchased or obtained by any means. He gives it only because of His grace. Ephesians 2:8a
- d) V 25 The **BLOOD** of Jesus Christ ALONE SATISFIES God for sin.
- e) V 26 In His righteousness there had to be an appropriate **sacrifice** or He would not be just, legally right in forgiving the sin of the one who believes, trusts in Jesus, for His righteousness.
- f) V 27-28We are **justified** declared to be without sin by faith in Jesus and not in our own efforts or works.

Galatians 2:16

- g) At the point of Belief or **Faith** in Jesus Christ:
 - (i) God declares that person **JUST** or **RIGHTEOUS** and gives him HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS.
 Romans 3:22, 46 2 Corinthians 5:21
 - (ii) Being now Righteous, the **Holy Spirit** comes to dwell "in" that person.

Romans 8:9-11 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19

1 Corinthians 3:16

16 Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

This is being "BORN OF THE SPIRIT"

John 3:5-8

or being "BORN AGAIN"

23 having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,

4. THE DEATH OF THE SAVIOR WAS: **RECONCILING**

To restore to a right relationship.

a) Were Enemies But Reconciled Romans 5:10

Romans 5:10

10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

- (i) Were **enemies**, but changed to a right, friendly relationship by God. This happened at a point in the past, at the Cross where sin was paid for and removed.
- b) New Creation through Reconciliation

2 Corinthians 5:17-21

5. THE DEATH OF THE SAVIOR WAS **SANCTIFYING.**

Separated, set apart, from common condition and use. Dedicated. Hebrews 9:21-22

Hebrews 9:21-22

21 Then likewise he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the ministry. 22 And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.

Purity in character - holy.

- a) **POSITION** \rightarrow IN Christ (spiritually). He did it. A past, completed work.
 - (i) His work- His responsibility. **1 Corinthians 1:30**
 - (ii) Accomplished at Calvary. **Hebrews 10:10; 13:12 Colossians 1:22**
 - (iii) Entrance to salvation. **2 Thessalonians 2:13**

b) **PROGRESSIVE** → Christ IN you (soul) - My Responsibility.

(i) Through Obedience. 1 Peter 1:14-16, 22

(ii) His on-going work Hebrews 10:14

(iii) Our part. 2 Corinthians 7:1

6. THE DEATH OF JESUS CHRIST WAS **HEALING.**

a) His Stripes Isaiah 53:4-5 1 Peter 2:24

b) Bore our Sickness **Matthew 8:17**

- 7. THE DEATH and SHED BLOOD of JESUS CHRIST ALONE **SATISFIED** GOD.
 - a) Jesus Christ completely SATISFIED the just demands of a Holy God for the judgment of sin by HIS BLOOD SHED ON THE CROSS.
 - (i) The BLOOD of JESUS CHRIST is the ONLY SATISFACTION FOR SIN ACCEPTABLE to God. Romans 3:25 Exodus 12:13
 - (ii) The Satisfaction for the sin of the world. 1 John 2:2; 4:10
 - b) THEREFORE THE BELIEVER HAS BEEN **SAVED!**

I approach God through the BLOOD ALONE. NEVER BY MY MERIT. Hebrews 4:16; 10:22 Boldness. Because of the Blood.

- E. The resurrection of the Savior, Jesus Christ
 - 1. Declared to be the Son of God with power. **Romans 1:4**
 - 2. The declaration that His sacrifice, His death and shed blood had been received and sin WAS REMOVED. **Romans 4:25**
 - 3. Those who are justified by His blood will also be raised to eternal life and see Him. **John 14:19**

F. The enthroned Savior, Jesus Christ.

1. **Hebrews 1:3**

3 who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high

2. Can Enter the Holy Place

Hebrews 9:21-24

He sprinkled the Holiest in the heavenly with His own blood, FOR US. Therefore we CAN ENTER the Holy Place.

3. Boldness to Enter

Hebrews 10:19

4. Intercede for Us

Hebrews 7:25 John 17 Romans 8:34-39 1 John 2:1

The PERFECT Priest made a PERFECT Sacrifice and is pleading a PERFECT case and will bring us to a PERFECT SALVATION.

- G. Obtaining salvation from the Savior.
 - 1. Neglect not the great Salvation Hebrews 2:1-4 If we neglect this great Salvation we will not escape from $sin \rightarrow judgment \rightarrow wrath \rightarrow death$.
 - 2 Grace of God brought Salvation (New Addition) **Titus 2:11**

The grace of God has brought Salvation to all men.

- 3. Power of God brought Salvation (New Addition) Romans 1:16

 The power of God for Salvation is through hearing the gospel.
- 4. Repentance leads to Salvation (*New Addition*) **2 Corinthians 7:9-10**

Upon hearing there must be a repentance which leads to salvation.

1 Thessalonians 1:9-10 Luke 5:32; 24:47 Acts 11:18; 2:38; 2 Peter 3:9

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- 5. Confession with the mouth brought Salvation Romans 10:9-18
- 6. Call on the name of God brought Salvation **Psalm 116:1-13**
